

GENERAL HEALTH POLICY

People with MS are particularly vulnerable to infection which could adversely affect their MS symptoms. Our priority is to protect members attending the Centre from unnecessary exposure to harmful infections.

'All persons' in the points below refer to all therapists, staff, members, volunteers and visitors to the Centre.

1. All persons with an infection, such as a cold, flu, Covid19 (C19), diarrhoea and vomiting, urinary tract infection (UTI), a high temperature or generally feeling unwell, are asked not to attend the Centre until they are free from all symptoms .
2. If you or a member of your family have recently been admitted to hospital, you are asked to remain vigilant with regards to C.Difficile, Norovirus and Covid19 and to ensure you are clear from these infections before returning to the Centre.
3. Antiseptic hand gel is provided at the Centre.
4. All persons are required to wash and sanitise their hands regularly
5. Physiotherapy equipment is cleaned daily using disinfectant solution.
6. A general domestic clean of the building is undertaken weekly
7. All persons are required to wear facial coverings whilst moving around the Centre. These can be removed once seated.
